The Brain & Stress: What's Happening and What We Can Do About It

Are you consistently feeling overwhelmed and under stress? Christine Bright, MBA, Center for Healing and Justice through Sport, will explain the biology of the brain under stress focusing on how the brain works, develops, changes when impacted by overwhelming stress and trauma including (Adverse Childhood Experiences ACEs). Christine will share strategies for all ages on how to respond to stress using your “thinking brain” rather than your “survival brain.” This shift will help us stay focused at school and work, develop healthy relationships and increase overall wellbeing.
