



The Northland Foundation recently conducted a study which highlighted the growing community concern regarding our region's shortfall of 4,500 licensed childcare openings. Duluth needs at least 1,100 more childcare openings. It is an expanding crisis which is negatively impacting our community's ability to attract and retain young families.
